OR Do you want to learn the basics of making a sweater without all the sweat equity of a full-blown adult-sized sweater? Or do you have a cutie pie you just HAVE TO whip up a sweater for? If any of these scenarios are true, this IS THE CLASS FOR YOU! Learn the basics of a knitted top-down sweater construction with minimal seaming & a raglan sleeve – just FUN-sized. And good GLORY do we have some sweet yarns for the bambino in your life! There are multiple offerings for this 2-session class taught by Yarnista & Owner Susan Dickerson:

**Skills required:** Long tail cast on, knit, purl

**What you will learn:** KFB, YO, K2Tog, knitting in the round, basic sweater construction, joining yarns

**Materials:** 522 yards of DK yarn (we recommend any Dreambaby or Dreambaby Paintpot), US size 4 and 6 circular needles with 16" cables, US size 6 circular needle with 24" cable, stitch markers, tapestry needle for weaving ends, knit gauge checker

**HOMEWORK:** Knit a 4" x 4" swatch (stockinette stitch – knit on right side & purl on wrong side) with your needles & yarn and confirm gauge prior to 1<sup>st</sup> class \*\*

**Pattern:** [Plymouth's 2833 Pullover](#), included in class price.

**Cost:** \$70 with 24-hour advance reservation / \$80 walk-in



**\*\*Notes for the Beginning Baby Sweater:** You will be writing on your pattern. Please bring a copy if you don't want to mark your original. You will need to confirm your gauge prior to class. Please purchase your yarn in advance of the class and knit a 4" by 4" swatch with the US 6 needles and bring to class. Use your gauge checker to confirm you are knitting at 5 ½ stitches per inch. If you need assistance with checking your gauge, please come by the shop.

## Blocking Basics

You've knitted your shawl or scarf, and your project looks funny after you have bound off. You need to now BLOCK your final project! Those gorgeous knit stitches aren't going to come out perfect. Once finished, you have to tell those stitches where and how to sit.

Yarnista & Owner Susan Dickerson will lead this 1-session blocking basics held:

- 10 am to 12 pm Tuesday, Aug. 14
- 3 to 5 pm Thursday, Sept. 6
- 10 am to 12 pm Tuesday, Oct. 2

Susan will run you through different yarns, how each performs with blocking and with samples of before and after blocked items. She will talk about steam blocking, spray blocking, how to block acrylic, use of lace wires & T-pins. The class will block one item during the class.

**Class Level:** Advanced Beginner

**Skills required:** You must be able to cast on, knit, purl, and bind off

**What you will learn:** Importance of gauge, top-down sweater construction without seams, pattern & chart reading, M1L, M1R, using waste yarn to hold stitches, knit sleeves top down on magic loop, picking up stitches for ribbing and binding off in pattern

**Materials:** 5 colors of fingering weight yarn WOUND (adult version requires 800 to 1475 yards; child version required 252 to 773 yards), size 3 & 5 circular needles with 24" AND 32" cables or comparable needles to achieve gauge, stitch markers, tape measure, gauge guide, tapestry needle for yarn tails, waste yarn for placing work on hold, scissors, a pencil, a highlighter\*\*

**HOMEWORK:** Knit a 4" x 4" swatch (stockinette stitch – knit on right side & purl on wrong side) with your needles & yarn and confirm gauge PRIOR to 1<sup>st</sup> class (please see us if you need assistance). Stitch gauge should be 25 stitches & 32 rows = 4" (6.25 stitches & 8 rows = 1")

**Pattern:** [So Faded Adult](#) or [So Faded Pint Sized](#) by Andrea Mowry, \$7 electronic or \$9 in-store purchase

**\*\*Notes for So Faded:** You will be writing on your pattern. Please bring a copy if you don't want to mark your original. Have 1 or 2 skeins of your yarn wound prior to class if it comes in hanks. If you are uncertain of your size or the number of skeins you need, remember that wound yarn cannot be returned.

And better still, brioche fabric is truly as squishy and luxurious as its namesake, the light and buttery brioche bun, making it just right for cozy cold weather accessories. **You must have completed the BRIOCHE TECHNIQUE CLASS PRIOR TO THIS two-color brioche class.** This 2-session class will be taught by Yarnista & Owner Susan Dickerson and will be held:

Shop sample is 7.5" wide and used 2 skeins of worsted weight yarn)

**HOMEWORK:** Cast on the pattern's 218 stitches and knit the 5 rows (you can half this pattern with 110 stitches)

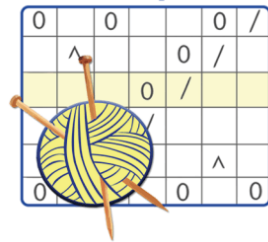
